This half term we will be reading:

As well as reading our phonics books, we will be reading a range of exciting books as a whole class.

This half term we will be writing:

The text types we will be looking at are narrative and a recount. We will still be focusing on sentence constructions (Capital letters, finger spaces, full stops, etc.)

Maths learning:

We are going to be looking at place value within 10 and addition and subtraction within 10.
