This half term we will be reading:

As well as reading our phonics books, we will be reading a range of exciting books as a whole class.

This half term we will be writing:

Narrative story (fiction) based on 'The friendship Bench' by Wendy Medour and a non-fiction diary of 'The Great Fire of London'

Maths learning:

Addition & Subtraction and Shape.

Science learning:

We are going to be looking at different materials and sustainability.

Computing learning:

We will be looking at 'Spreadsheets' and to understand what they are used for.

History learning:

We are going to look 'The Great Fire of London' and how it started.

DT learning:

We will be exploring how puppets are made and will create our own puppet from a design criteria.

P.E learning:

Dance - to create theme related shapes, movements and actions

Music learning:

We are exploring pulse and rhythmic patterns.

PSHE learning:
