

Spring 1 Curriculum Overview – Year 2 Love, Honesty, Forgiveness, Respect, Hope

This half term we will be reading:

As well as reading our phonics books, we will be reading a range of exciting books as a whole class.

This half term we will be writing:

A fable based on the book 'The Crow's Tale' by Naomi Howarth.

Maths learning:

We are going to be learning about money and we will be starting to learn how to multiply and divide in multiples of 2, 5 and 10.

Science learning:

We are going to be exploring plants and how they react to light and dark. We will also start to explore living things and their habitat.

Computing learning:

We will be learning about spreadsheets and questioning for effective searching.

Geography learning:

We are going to be comparing and contrasting our local area with China.

Art learning:

We will be exploring the work of Claude Monet and creating a piece of artwork inspired by him.

P.E learning:

We will be doing Gymnastics and learning how to move our bodies in a range of ways.

Music learning:

We are going to embracing music and investigating the mood and pictures of music changes.

PSHE learning:

We will be focusing on dreams and goals including being realistic and celebrating achievements.
