## This half term we will be reading:

As well as reading our phonics books, we will be reading a range of exciting books as a whole class.

## This half term we will be writing:

We will be writing a poem, character description and a narrative based on Mr Benn.

## Maths learning:

We are going to be looking at Statistics including reading and creating tables. We will be working on position and language to describe movements. We will also be learning to tell the time to the closest 15-minute intervals. We will then recap what we have learnt so far.

## Science learning:

We are going to bulbs and seeds; how humans and different animals grow up and wildlife.

## Computing learning:

We will be making music and presenting ideas on purple mash.

## History/Geography learning:

We are going to learn about past and present monarchs along with significant events. We will also be exploring the history of flight.

## Design Technology learning:

We will be looking at the nutrition of food and following instructions to make bread.

## P.E learning:

We will be learning athletics including running, jumping, throwing and catching.

## Music learning:

We are going to make melodies and performing simple musical accompaniments.

## PSHE learning:

We will be focusing relationships and how to make and keep positive relationships.

## R.E learning:

We are continuing to look at how we should care for others and the world and why it matters.
