This half term we will be reading:

Charlotte's Web by E.B. White. James and the Giant Peach by Roald Dahl

This half term we will be writing:

A comedy narrative based on a Roald Dahl book, Non-Fiction writing and an explanation text.

Maths learning:

Place Value. Addition. Subtraction.

Daily Times Tables

Science learning:

We will be learning about Skeletons, Movement and Diet & Nutrition.

Computing learning:

We will be working on purple mash learning Coding and Online Safety.

History and Geography learning:

We will be studying Geography this half term, focusing upon The U.K. and the use of land.

Art learning:

We will be developing our drawing and painting skills with the artwork of George Seurat.

P.E learning:

Invasion Games: Football

Spanish learning:

La fonetica (Phonics 1). Aprendo espanol (I am learning Spanish).

Music learning:

Pulse; Exploring Call & Response rhythm patterns.

PSHE learning:

Our topic will be 'Being Me in My World.'

RE learning:

Our topic will be 'Why is The Bible so important for Christians today?'

What else can I do at home?

Read every day and complete reading diaries. These are checked every Monday or Tuesday. Parental/carer comments are highly encouraged.

Practice times tables: children need to know the x2 x5 x10 x 3 x4 x8 by the end of Year 3. This includes division.

Read books by Roald Dahl (our author of the half term).

Practice addition & subtraction.

Explore your local area, noticing the different ways land is used e.g. housing, industrial, commercial, public parks, farming etc.
