## This half term we will be reading:

The sheep pig by Dick King-Smith

## This half term we will be writing:

Letters and Setting Descriptions based on the book 'The Gardener' by Sarah Stewart

## Maths learning:

We will be learning about mass and capacity, fractions and money.

We will also practise our times tables and arithmetic.

## Science learning:

We will be learning about plants. We will identify different parts of a plant, learn the job of each part and grow plants too.

## What else can I do at home?

- Read everyday
- Practice times tables:
- Look at money and identify different coins and notes. Put them in order from smallest to biggest and vice versa.
- Add up the cost of items
- Calculate the amount of change needed
- Help to measure cooking ingredients (grams; millilitres; litre)
- Measure items around the home with a tape measure (cm, m)
- Practise using mathematical language like  $\frac{1}{2}$   $\frac{1}{4}$   $\frac{3}{4}$  and 1 whole.
- Listen to music and try to identify the vocals. Listen to how voice is used to create different sounds.
- Grow and look after plants.
